5	WHEREAS,	the CSG is a single grant program consisting of several levels of qualification, each
6		level having specific requirements that determine the amount of funding that an
7		eligible grantee will be awarded. CPB determines the appropriate CSG funding level
8		based on the information provided by the applicant; and
9	WHEREAS,	the CPB requires that all applicants spent approximately 30% of CSG funding on costs
10		relating to the acquisition or production of national programming; and
11	WHEREAS,	CSG funding is restricted to operational support of radio broadcast operations and
12		does not provide for administrative cost rates normally applied to grants as indirect
13		cost, therefore making it necessary that the established in direct cost rate of the nation
14		be waived for this grant; and
15	WHEREAS,	KOHN anticipates that it will be eligible for at least \$65,000, and has presented to the
16		Cultural Preservation Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee a
17		preliminary budget and request formal approval to submit an application to the
18		Corporation for Public Broadcasting for a Community Service Grant funding.
19	NOW, THER	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
20		and authorizes KOHN 91.9 FM to submit an application for the Community Service
21		Grant from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting and waives the indirect cost for
22		this grant.
