

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Ratifying the Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program
FY 2005 Budget Amendment #I/Modification #II)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-315

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council has previously supported the Nation's**
2 **Education Department in submitting a grant proposal and establishing the Vocational**
3 **Rehabilitation Program (Resolution No. 03-149); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant under Section 121 of the**
5 **Rehabilitation Act (Vocational Rehabilitation Services Projects for American Indians**
6 **with Disabilities) and received grant notification number H250D030012; and**

7 **WHEREAS, services under the Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program are**
8 **provided to eligible American Indians with disabilities who reside on the Tohono**
9 **O'odham Nation, with enrolled members given priority; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Vocational Rehabilitation Program must ensure the facility is maintained and**
11 **meets the requirements of 34 C.F.R. Section 361.51, Standards for Facilities and**
12 **Provider of Services, which states any facility used in connection with the delivery of**
13 **vocational rehabilitation services under this part meets program accessibility**
14 **requirements consistent with the requirements, as applicable, of the Architectural**
15 **Barriers Act of 1968, the American with Disabilities Act of 1990, section 504 of the Act,**
16 **and the regulations implementing those laws; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Vocational Rehabilitation Program's parking area is a barrier to individuals with**
18 **mobility issues (individuals who use wheelchairs, are fitted with leg prosthetics, or**
19 **possess low/no vision), which makes it difficult to enter the building without**
20 **assistance, and Vocational Rehabilitation Program has therefore utilized funds to**
21 **construct a paved parking area; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the total cost of the paving project was \$20,800.00, which exceeded the \$5,000.00**
23 **capital purchase budget requirement and was funded through a depreciation line**
24 **item; and**

25 **WHEREAS, line item 750 - Capital Equipment was added to the Vocational Rehabilitation Program**
26 **FY 2005 budget, and \$7,000.00 from 772 - Repair and Maintenance Building and**
27 **\$13,800.00 from 856 - Client Support was moved to the 750 - Capital Equipment line**
28 **item; and**

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1 **WHEREAS, because the Capital Equipment line item was added during the FY 2005 closeout**
2 **process and FY 2005 has closed, it is necessary for the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
3 **Council to ratify these actions, including the addition of line item 750-Capital**
4 **Equipment, by approving the attached Vocational Rehabilitation Program FY 2005**
5 **Budget Amendment #I/Modification #II, which is hereby incorporated by this**
6 **reference.**

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby (1)**
8 **approves the Vocational Rehabilitation Program FY 2005 Budget Amendment**
9 **#I/Modification #II effective retroactive to October 1, 2004 and (2) ratifies the**
10 **expenditure of such funds in accordance with the laws and policies of the Nation and**
11 **applicable grant requirements.**

12 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH day**
13 **of MAY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,597.5 FOR; 169.0 AGAINST;**
14 **506.9 NOT VOTING; and 167.4 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
15 **Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
16 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
17 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
18 **Stat. 984).**


