2		Education Department in submitting a grant proposal and establishing the Vocational
3		Rehabilitation Program under Resolution No. 03-149; and
4	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant under the Rehabilitation Services
5		Administration's Section 121 (Vocational Rehabilitation Services Projects for
6		American Indians with Disabilities) of the Rehabilitation Act and received grant
7		notification number H250D030012; and
8	WHEREAS,	services under the Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program will
9		be provided to eligible American Indians with disabilities who reside on the Tohono
10		O'odham Nation, with enrolled members being priority; and
11	WHEREAS,	the services provided will be consistent with individuals strengths, resources,
12		priorities, concerns, abilities, capabilities, and informed choices so that they may
13		prepare for and engage in gainful employment; and
14	WHEREAS,	a carryover of \$20,458.45 has been identified from fiscal year 2005, and is being
15		included into the current program budget of \$400,000.00, which will increase the
16		budget to \$420,458.45.
17	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
18		fiscal year 2006 Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program budget
19		Amendment reflecting carryover funds of \$20,458.45 added to the current program
20		budget of \$400,000.00 for the grand total of \$420,458.45.
21	BE IT FINAL	LY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
22		Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairwoman is authorized to execute and expend the
23		grant award to September 30, 2006, and provide continued culturally appropriate
24		vocational rehabilitation services to its eligible clients, provided however, that any
25		amendments affecting the funding level of this grant shall be submitted for further
26		approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
