

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the San Xavier District to submit a FY 2006 ICDBG proposal to HUD
and to administer the grant program if awarded)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-318

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council support the**
2 **District in their efforts to improve quality of life for their communities and members;**
3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, efforts to improve quality of life in any one District are beneficial for the Nation as a**
5 **whole; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) offers money for housing**
7 **rehabilitation under its Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG)**
8 **Program; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Housing Department has a waiting list of community homes**
10 **and community facilities that are sub-standard and in need of rehabilitation; and**

11 **WHEREAS, neither the Tohono O'odham Nation nor the Ki:ki Association is applying for the ICDBG**
12 **this year; and**

13 **WHEREAS, San Xavier is eligible for ICDBG monies, as P.L. 93-638 title I eligible entity, provided**
14 **a concurring resolution is obtained from the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council;**
15 **and**

16 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier Housing Department has the capacity to implement projects under the**
17 **ICDBG, and the District's Grants Manager and Finance Department have the capacity**
18 **to administer this award; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District had applied for a second ICDBG Program in the amount of \$1.7**
20 **million within the last 12 months, however was not awarded; and**

21 **WHEREAS, San Xavier District is now requesting support for the ICDBG Program application to**
22 **HUD in the amount of \$2,197,706.34; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District agrees to accept all responsibilities for the implementation**
24 **and maintenance of rehabilitation efforts carried out under this ICDBG Program; and**

25 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council, at its regular meeting on April 18, 2006, approved**
26 **submission of this grant and requests a concurring resolution from the Tohono**
27 **O'odham Legislative Council; and**

1 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District went before the Housing Committee and the Budget and**
2 **Finance Committee to make its presentation.**

3 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the**
4 **San Xavier District to submit an application to HUD for the FY 2006 ICDBG Program.**

5 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that should the grant be awarded, San Xavier District will further submit**
6 **for approval and acceptance of the final budget and that any amendments affecting**
7 **the funding levels will be submitted for further prior approval by this council.**

8 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH day**
9 **of MAY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,273.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
10 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 167.4 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
11 **1(c)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
12 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
13 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
14 **Stat. 984).**


