

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving NCAI Grant Saving for FY-06 Budget Appropriation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-326

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Approved Resolution No. 04-538 accepting**
2 **and authorized expending of a \$10,000.00 grant received from the National Congress**
3 **of American Indians Education Fund for the purpose of voter registration and voter**
4 **mobilization for state and federal elections; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the NCAI grant was used toward the 2004 "Get Out the Vote" Project conducted by the**
6 **Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the 2004 "Get Out the Vote" Project resulted in success with:**

- 8 1. **an increase of 955 new voters registered**
- 9 2. **850 Early Votes Cast During General Election**
- 10 3. **An increase from 57% to 59% Voter Turn Out; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the 2006 state and federal election serves to be an important election for the state**
12 **of Arizona and the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation continues to recognize the importance of Tohono**
14 **O'odham Nation members participating in the democratic process as citizens of the**
15 **United States of American and has begun another "Get Out the Vote" Project for the**
16 **2006 state and federal election; and**

17 **WHEREAS, there exists savings from the FY-2005 10,000 grant appropriation; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Executive Office has identified saving in the amount of \$6,203.69 from the NCAI**
19 **grant received in 2004 and has determined from NCAI that the remaining funds can**
20 **be expended for future Native Vote endeavors; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Executive Office has presented the attached budget in the amount of \$6,203.69**
22 **for use toward the 2006 "Get Out the Vote" project on the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

23 **NOW ,THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
24 **use of NCAI grant saving of \$6,203.69 from the \$10,000.00 NCAI grant received in 2004.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the attached**
26 **budget and authorizes the Executive Office to expend funds from this budget for FY-**
27 **06.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22ND day**
29 **of MAY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,271.8 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
30 **169.0 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1**
31 **(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
32 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
33 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
34 **Stat. 984).**
