

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Savings of the Grant Award for the USEPA Brownfields 128(a)
Tribal Response Grant Modification #1)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-337

1 **WHEREAS, in Resolution No.04-621 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepted \$150,000**
2 **in new funding for the continuation of the Brownfields Section 128(a) Tribal Response**
3 **Program; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Brownfields Section 128(a) Tribal Response Program Grant extends from October**
5 **1, 2003 through September 31, 2005; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the savings from FY 2003 in the amount of \$32,213.78 was approved in Resolution #05-**
7 **534; and**

8 **WHEREAS, there is an additional savings from FY 2005 of \$45,273.06 and the attached budget**
9 **modification #1 identifies where the savings will be allocated for funds to be**
10 **expended for the remainder of FY 2006 for a total of \$77,486.85; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the program is adding five new line items: 630 Insurance, 650 Tuition & Registration,**
12 **660 Travel Expense, 661 Mileage POV, and 721 Other Supplies.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**
14 **the savings budget in the amount of \$45,273.06 from the Brownfields Section 128(a)**
15 **Tribal Response Program for a total of \$77,486.85 in the following manner:**

- 16 **1. Adding the FY 2005 remaining budget (\$45,273.06) into the FY 2006 Budget**
17 **(\$32,213.78);**
- 18 **2. Line items 630 Insurance, 650 Tuition & Registration, 660 Travel Expense, 661**
19 **Mileage POV, and 721 Other Supplies to be included in the FY 2006 Brownfields**
20 **Budget;**
- 21 **3. Authorizing TON EPA to expend all available funds awarded pursuant to**
22 **Cooperative Agreement BP-98918901-5.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-chairman and any designated official**
25 **are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**
26 **amendments affecting the funding or funding level of the grant shall be submitted**
27 **for further prior approval.**

8 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
9 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




