(Approving FY 2006 Budget Amendment No. 4 for the Tohono O'odham Nation
Police Department 638 BIA Law Enforcement Program to Establish 712-Gas, Oil
and Coolants and 771-RM Vehicles)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-339

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation under the 638 BIA Master Contract contracts its own Law**
2 **Enforcement, Corrections and Ranger Programs; and**

3 **WHEREAS, TONPD has savings derived from vacant positions leaving five (5) months salary**
4 **available for new Personnel; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the program has identified the need to utilize these salary savings for Gas, Oil and**
6 **Coolants and RM Vehicles for Program vehicles; and**

7 **WHEREAS, in order to provide essential fluids and repair and maintenance of program vehicles**
8 **these line items need to be established; and**

9 **WHEREAS, under the FY 2006 BIA 638 Law Enforcement Budget there are no line items for 712-**
10 **Gas, Oil and Coolants and 771-RM Vehicles.**


11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it**
12 **hereby approves and authorizes Budget Amendment No. 4 for TONPD Law**
13 **Enforcement BIA 638 Contract Budget account no. 10-1090.**

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the**
15 **establishment of line items 712-Gas, Oil and Coolants and 771-RM Vehicles.**


16 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Vice Chairman is hereby authorized**
17 **to negotiate and execute the budget provided and that any amendments affecting the**
18 **funding or funding levels of this budget shall be submitted for approval to the Tohono**
19 **O'odham Nation Legislative Council.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH. Day**
21 **of JUNE, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,230.3 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
22 **210.50 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
23 **1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
24 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
25 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
26 **Stat. 984).**
