

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Savings Budget Modification/Amendment #2 of Carry-over Savings
of \$111,942.74 of the Grant Award for the General Assistance Program (GAP) Grant)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-342

1 **WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 05-532, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepted \$260,085**
2 **in new funding for the continuation of the Indian Environmental General Assistance**
3 **Program (GAP); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the GAP Grant project period extends from August 1, 2002 through July 31, 2006; and**

5 **WHEREAS, as part of a continuation grant, savings from the FY 2004 Budget (\$43,949.55 was**
6 **included as part of the FY 2006 Budget per Resolution #05-533); and**

7 **WHEREAS, as part of a continuation grant, there remains a savings from the FY 2005 Budget**
8 **(\$111,942.74 needs to be included as part of the FY 2006 Budget); and**

9 **WHEREAS, the attached budget identifies where the savings amount of \$111,942.74 will be**
10 **allocated so that these funds may be expended during the FY2006; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the program is adding two new line items: 722 Program supplies and 750 Major**
12 **capital equipment.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**
14 **the savings budget in the amount of \$111,942.74 for the GAP Grant in the following**
15 **manner:**

- 16 **1. Adding the FY 2005 carry-over savings of (111,942.74) into the FY 2006 Budget**
17 **(\$304,034.55).**
- 18 **2. Adding new line items 722 Program Supplies and 750 Major Capital Equipment to**
19 **be included in the FY 2006 GAP Budget.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that Tohono O'odham**
21 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-chairman and any designated official**
22 **are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**
23 **amendments affecting the funding or funding level of the grant shall be submitted**
24 **for further prior approval.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05th Day**
26 **of JUNE, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,344.25 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
27 **96.55 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1**
28 **(d)(2)(3) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
29 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




