15		deposited into an identified account for Choulic Community, and a budget				
16		modification from Choulic Community.

18		Choulic Community's request to establish a revenue account and budget, and that a				
19		check in the amount of \$2,000.00 received from the Solid Waste Program for gravel				
20		sales be deposited into Baboquivari District's General Savings account, identifying				
21		the funds as Choulic Community.
