

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Revenue Account and Budget from Gravel Sales of the Choulic Community)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-364

1 **WHEREAS, at a regular scheduled meeting on June 05, 2006, of the Baboquivari District Council,**
2 **the Choulic Community Representative presented a request to establish a revenue**
3 **account, and presented a budget in the amount of \$2,000.00; and**

4 **WHEREAS, at a meeting of the Choulic Community on April 02, 2006, a motion was made to create**
5 **a new budget for revenues generated by gravel sales, and at this meeting it was**
6 **requested by the community to deposit a check in the amount of \$2,000.00 from the**
7 **gravel sales into Baboquivari District's General Savings Account identifying this**
8 **account as Choulic Community, with a vote count of 5 FOR; 0 AGAINST; 2 NOT VOTING;**
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, after reviewing the new budget, it was apparent that additional checks for gravel**
11 **sales would be ongoing, and that after receiving additional checks the Choulic**
12 **community will continue to deposit into an identified account for the Choulic**
13 **Community with budget modifications to the amount(s); and**

14 **WHEREAS, that all additional checks received for gravel sales by the Choulic Community will be**
15 **deposited into an identified account for Choulic Community, and a budget**
16 **modification from Choulic Community.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
18 **Choulic Community's request to establish a revenue account and budget, and that a**
19 **check in the amount of \$2,000.00 received from the Solid Waste Program for gravel**
20 **sales be deposited into Baboquivari District's General Savings account, identifying**
21 **the funds as Choulic Community.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the budget**
23 **shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
24 **Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH. Day**
26 **of [JUNE, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,188.9 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
27 **84.5 NOT VOTING; and 167.4 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
29 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




