

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the FY 06 Schuk Toak District Budget Modification and Amendment No.1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-367**

1 **WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District presented to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council the**  
2 **District's FY06 Budget Amendment No. 1 which includes budget modifications and**  
3 **amendments from District Administration and four (4) Communities for the fiscal**  
4 **year; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the District's budget modifications in its administrative budget utilizes identified**  
6 **savings in salaries and fringe benefits line items and in addition transfers funds from**  
7 **the major capital equipment and professional services line items to other budgetary**  
8 **line items where the need for additional funds have been identified as detailed in the**  
9 **attached documents and does not increase the Administration budget total allocated**  
10 **amount of \$537,362.00; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council did meet on May 27, 2006 and approved the Pan Tak**  
12 **Community budget modification and amendment and did also meet on June 1, 2006**  
13 **and approved the Queens Well, San Isidro and Sil Nakya Community budget**  
14 **modifications and amendments as detailed in the attached documents as presented;**

16 **WHEREAS, the total budget amounts for the following communities being presented for**  
17 **modification and amendment are as follows:**



6 **WHEREAS, the district's Summer Youth Program budget in the amount of \$74,816.00 does not**  
7 **require any modification or amendment at this time; and**  
8 **WHEREAS, the combined FY06 district Administration, Summer Youth Program and (9)**  
9 **Community budget total of \$1,107,178.00 remains at the level approved by Tohono**  
10 **O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 05-659.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
12 **the Schuk Toak District FY06 Budget Modifications and Amendment No. 1 to the total**  
13 **district budget detailed in the attached documents and incorporated within this**  
14 **resolution without increasing the total allocated amount of \$1,107,178.00 as**  
15 **approved by Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 05-659 as presented**  
16 **to be expended in accordance with the attached budgets.**

17 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09<sup>th</sup> Day**  
18 **of JUNE, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,104.4 FOR; -0-**  
19 **AGAINST; 169.0 NOT VOTING; and 167.4 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
20 **by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**  
21 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
22 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
23 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


