

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the CDC Effective Strategies to Reduce Motor Vehicle Injuries Among
American Indians and Alaska Natives Cooperative Agreement Budget Amendment)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-383

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been administering a CDC Effective Strategies to**
2 **Reduce Motor Vehicle Injuries Among American Indians and Alaska Natives**
3 **Cooperative Agreement; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Year Two budget originally awarded for this cooperative agreement totals**
5 **\$71,480.00; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the CDC approved the carry-forward of \$24,133.00 in unused funds from Year One of**
7 **the project to Year Two of the Project; and**

8 **WHEREAS, a total of \$2,370.00 will be added to Travel Expense; and**

9 **WHEREAS, a total of \$1,000.80 will be added to Supplies-Office; and**

10 **WHEREAS, a total of \$7,220.00 will be added to Supplies - Other; and**

11 **WHEREAS, a total of \$6,282.57 will be added to Public Relations; and**

12 **WHEREAS, a total of \$5,000.00 will be added to Consultants; and**

13 **WHEREAS, all other line items will remain the same, for a new budget total of \$95,613.00.**


14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

15 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the budget**
16 **amendment and modification as outlined, which increases the Year Two Budget**
17 **from \$71,480.00 to \$95,613.00.**

18 **2. The Tohono O'odham Nation officials, to wit: the Chairwoman and Vice Chairman**
19 **and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the**
20 **Intergovernmental Agreement and expend funds.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19TH Day**
22 **of JUNE, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,247.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
23 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 193.1 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
24 **1 (d)(2) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
25 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
26 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
27 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


