

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending STEPS to a Healthier US Grant, STEPS to a Healthier Arizona Initiative
(October 1, 2005 – September 30, 2006))

RESOLUTION NO. 06-388

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has applied, and been approved to receive \$436,941 in**
2 **competitive funding from the Arizona Department of Health Services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 99-149, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**
4 **establishment of the Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program, funded by the**
5 **Special Diabetes Programs for Indians, authorized by the Balanced Budget Act of**
6 **1997; and**

7 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2000-182, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**
8 **name change of the Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program to the Healthy**
9 **O'odham Promotion Program; and**

10 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 05-579, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did approve the**
11 **STEPS to a Healthier US Grant, STEPS to a Healthier Arizona Initiative Fiscal Year 2006**
12 **base budget of \$436,941; and**

13 **WHEREAS, budget amendment number one is presented to increase Tuition and Registration**
14 **line item, add Food line item, and adjust Indirect Cost Charges from 17.10% to 17.98%**
15 **for effective period October 1, 2005 to September 30, 2006.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 17 **1. Approves the Division of Health Promotion Program amended STEPS program**
18 **budget of \$436,941 for FY 2006.**
- 19 **2. Approves the addition of Food line item.**
- 20 **3. Approves adjustment of the Indirect Cost of 17.10% to 17.98% for effective period**
21 **October 1, 2005 to September 30, 2006.**
- 22 **4. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman and Vice Chairman**
23 **and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the**
24 **grant, provided, however, that any amendments affecting the funds or funding**
25 **levels of the contract shall be submitted for further approval.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19TH Day**
27 **of JUNE, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
28 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1**
29 **(d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
30 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
31 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
32 **Stat. 984).**




