

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services – FY2006
Division of Behavioral Health I.H.S. Budget Amendment-Account No. 10-1473)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-391

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health is**
2 **currently operating the Behavioral Health Division through an Indian Health**
3 **Services (I.H.S.) 638 Contract; and**

4 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 05-529, the Department of Health and**
5 **Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health, was approved by the Legislative**
6 **Council in the September general session; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the original budget reflected 17.1% in indirect costs; and this amendment reflects the**
8 **increase of the current indirect cost rate of 17.98%; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the FY2006 Division of Behavioral Health I.H.S. Budget Amendment in the amount of**
10 **\$3,732,615.48, has been submitted for review and approval by the Department of**
11 **Health and Human Services, for the Division of Behavioral Health.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

13 **1. The attached FY2006 Division of Behavioral Health I.H.S. Budget Amendment**
14 **reflects the increase of the current indirect cost rate from 17.1% to 17.98% is**
15 **hereby approved.**

16 **2. Approves and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the Department of**
17 **Health and Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health FY2006 I.H.S. budget**
18 **amendment in the amount of \$3,732,615.48.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
20 **Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official**
21 **are authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any**
22 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted**
23 **for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19TH Day**
25 **of JUNE, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
26 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**
27 **and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
30 **Stat. 984).**


