RESOLUTION NO. 06-392

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health is**
2 **currently operating the Behavioral Health Division through an Indian Health Services**
3 **(I.H.S.) 638 Contract. The Seriously Mentally II (SMI) Program is a comprehensive Day**
4 **Treatment Program for Seriously Mentally III and Developmental Disabled Adults,**
5 **services which includes educational sessions on general mental health and substance**
6 **abuse, community activities, work projects, and case management. The original SMI**
7 **funds from the I.H.S grant ended on August 31, 1990; and**

8 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 99-500, the Department of Health and**
9 **Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health, SMI Program has been collecting third**
10 **party reimbursement funds since September 1999 from the State of Arizona and has**
11 **since accumulated funds; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Division of Behavioral Health, has accumulated funds to cover the Third Party**
13 **Revenues Budget Account No. 18-1429 in the amount of \$148,972.03 for FY06**
14 **operational expenses (October 01, 2005 to September 30, 2006); and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Behavioral Health Division request to**
16 **amend the current resolution to increase the amount of \$136,142.00 to \$148,972.03 for**
17 **the addition of the cost shared Project Administrator position at 25% or \$3,715.41**
18 **prorated from June 19, 2006 through September 30, 2006 and fringe benefits to reflect**
19 **the salary. Cost share with MOH 50% and HOPP 25% to work on and complete our SMI**
20 **modular project for this FY2006; and increase \$8,000.00 line item Special Activities to**
21 **cover communities activities; and**

22 **WHEREAS, any future funds generated will be used for program staff support expenses, i.e.,**
23 **insurance, utilities, communication, supplies, repair & maintenance for vehicles,**
24 **equipment and building; food, gas, oil & coolants; client support and special medical**
25 **services; and**


26 **WHEREAS, a Third Party Revenue budget in the amount of \$148,972.03 for FY2006, has been**
