Enforcement, Corrections and Ranger Programs; and
WHEREAS, TONPD has received an increase in base funding of \$521,781.00 to be utilized for
program needs; and
$WHEREAS,\ TONPD\ has identified\ those\ needs\ to\ provide\ for\ training\ and\ registration; to\ purchase$
rifles, night vision goggles, ballistic vests; tactical vests, ammunition, vehicles
including police accessories, ATV's and trailers; and
WHEREAS, in order to purchase such equipment and supplies two account numbers need to be
established 10-1090-650-Tuition & Registration to provide for training and 10-1090-
728-Ammunition to purchase ammunition for usage by swat teams; and
WHEREAS, under the FY 2006 BIA 638 Law Enforcement Budget account no. 10-1090 there are no
line items for 650-Tuition and Registration and 728-Ammunition; and
WHEREAS, to establish a new position of Systems Administrator to maintain software programs
that are crucial to police information.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it
hereby approves and authorizes Budget Amendment No. 3 for addition to base funding
of \$521,781.00 for TONPD Law Enforcement BIA 638 Budget account no. 10-1090.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
establishment of line items 660-Tuition and Registration and 730-Ammunition.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the approval and authorization of the new position of Systems
Administrator.
BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Vice Chairman is hereby authorized
to negotiate and execute the budget provided that any amendments affecting the
funding or funding levels of this budget shall be submitted for approval to the Tohono
O'odham Nation Legislative Council.
