

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Wildland Fire Management/B.I.A-National Interagency Fire Center Division
Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-403

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation/Department of Public Safety/Fire Department has taken**
2 **over Operations of the P.L. 93-638, Wildland Fire Management (Preparedness) from**
3 **the Bureau of Indian Affairs to operate the program indefinitely; and**
4 **WHEREAS, funding has been provided by BIA Wildland P.L. 93-638, for the operation of the**
5 **Wildland Fire Management (Preparedness); and will be utilized to provide emergency**
6 **services in saving of lives, property, and protect the natural resources and wildlife of**
7 **the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
8 **WHEREAS, the Wildland Fire Management Division/Fire Department request approval to include**
9 **the FY 2005 carry forward funds of \$167,314.62 to the original FY 2006 Budget; and**
10 **WHEREAS, the Wildland Fire Management Division/Fire Department request approval to include**
11 **the additional \$17,500.00 (FY2005 Funding) and \$145,650.00, which total \$163,150.00**
12 **awarded by the National Interagency Fire Center to the original FY 2006 Budget; and**
13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
14 **FY 2005 carry forward identified savings of \$167,314.62 ending September 30, 2005,**
15 **and the increase of \$17,500.00 awarded by the Rural Fire Assistant and an additional**
16 **\$145,650, however \$36,850.00 will be deducted because Original FY 2006 was budgeted**
17 **at \$200,000.00, for a grand total of \$293,614.62.**
18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
19 **Nation's official, to wit; the Vice Chairman is hereby authorized to negotiate and**
20 **execute the contracts and plans, provided however, that any amendment affecting the**
21 **funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval**
22 **by this Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH Day**
24 **of JUNE, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
25 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**
26 **& (3) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
27 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
29 **Stat. 984).**


