

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2005 Carry-Forward Funds for the Johnson O'Malley Program
FY 2006 Budget Modification/Amendment #2 - Account # 10-1210)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-404

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Johnson O'Malley Program provides**
2 **supplemental financial assistance to support those programs in public schools**
3 **designed to meet the specialized and unique educational needs of eligible Native**
4 **American students enrolled at Indian Oasis/Baboquivari Unified School District, Gila**
5 **Bend Unified School District and the Tohono O'odham Nation Division of Early**
6 **Childhood Development; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Johnson O'Malley Program FY 2006 Budget is at \$149,317.00, and through the**
8 **Grants and Contract Office, has identified Carry-forward funds from the FY 2005**
9 **budget in the amount of \$33,886.19, bringing the FY 2006 Budget to \$210,155.78; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the FY 2006 Johnson O'Malley Program Modification/Amendment #2 reflects an**
11 **increase in line items 722 (Program Supplies), 771 Repair & Maintenance – Vehicle),**
12 **810 (Professional Services), 812 (Public Relations), 860 (Special Activities), and 900**
13 **(Indirect Cost).**

14 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Human Resources Development Committee and the**
15 **Budget and Finance Committees has reviewed and approved the Johnson O'Malley**
16 **Program Modification/Amendment #2.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
18 **Johnson O'Malley Program Modification/Amendment #2 Carry-forward funds from**
19 **the FY 2005 budget in the amount of \$33,886.19, bringing the FY 2006 Budget to**
20 **\$210,155.78.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Coordinator of the Johnson O'Malley Program will be cost-**
22 **shared with the Higher Education Services Program (30% Johnson O'Malley Program**
23 **& 70% Higher Education Services).**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the FY 2006 Johnson O'Malley Program Budget**
25 **Modification/Amendment #2 has decreased line items 610 (Salaries & Wages), 620**
26 **(Fringe Benefits); and increases line items 722 (Program Supplies), 771 Repair &**
27 **Maintenance – Vehicle), 810 (Professional Services), 812 (Public Relations), 860**
28 **(Special Activities) and 900 (Indirect Cost).**

2 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the budget provided that any amendment
3 affecting the funding or funding levels of the budget shall be submitted for approval
4 by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

5 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH Day
6 of JUNE, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
7 -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1
8 (d)(2) & (3) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
9 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
10 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
11 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


