

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Higher Education Services Program FY 2006 Budget Modification
/Amendment #1 - Account # 10-1215)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-407

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Higher Education Services Program has**
2 **been successfully providing counseling and financial assistance to eligible Tohono**
3 **O'odham to attend Post Secondary Institutes; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services Program FY 2006 Budget is at \$674,449.00, and the**
5 **Grants and Contracts Office has received an additional Bureau of Indian Affairs FY**
6 **2006 Allocation in the amount of \$664,338.00; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services Program, through the Grants and Contract Office, has**
8 **identified Carry-forward funds from the FY 2005 budget in the amount of \$134,654.76,**
9 **bringing the FY 2006 budget to \$809,725.96; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the salary of the Education Assistance Specialist will be cost-shared with the Johnson**
11 **O'Malley Program (70% Higher Education Services & 30% Johnson O'Malley); and**

12 **WHEREAS, the FY 2006 Higher Education Services Program Modification/Amendment #1 reflects**
13 **reducing line items 610 (Salaries), 620 (Fringe Benefits), 622 (Employee Security**
14 **Clearance), 660 (Travel Expense), 720 (Supplies - Office), 721 (Supplies - Other), 856**
15 **(Client Support), 860 (Special Activities), and 867 (Awards), to cover cost for continued**
16 **services; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the FY 2006 Higher Education Services Program Modification/Amendment #1 also**
18 **increases line item 626 (Allowances and Stipends); and**

19 **WHEREAS, the FY 2006 Higher Education Services Program Modification/Amendment #1 reflects**
20 **the change of the indirect cost from 17.79% to 17.98%.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the**
22 **Higher Education Services Program Budget Modification/Amendment #1 reflecting**
23 **the FY 2006 Final Allocation of \$664,338.00 and FY 2005 Carry-Forward funds in the**
24 **amount of \$134,654.76, bringing the FY 2006 budget to \$809,725.96.**

25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that salary of the Education Assistance Specialist will be cost-shared**
26 **with the Johnson O'Malley Program (70% Higher Education Services & 30% Johnson**
27 **O'Malley).**

28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the FY 2006 Higher Education Services Program Modification/**
29 **Amendment #1 reflects reducing line items 610 (Salaries), 620 (Fringe Benefits), 622**



1 (Employee Security Clearance), 660 (Travel Expense), 720 (Supplies - Office), 721
2 (Supplies - Other), 856 (Client Support), 860 (Special Activities), and 867 (Awards), and
3 increases line item 626 (Allowances and Stipends).


4 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Nation Chairwoman or Vice-Chairman is
5 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the budget provided that any amendment
6 affecting the funding or funding levels of the budget shall be submitted for approval
7 by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

8 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH Day
9 of JUNE, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
10 -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)
11 & (3) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
12 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
13 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
14 Stat. 984).




