

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving amendment #1 to increase the Water Resources Study Program FY2006 IHS  
MOA budget 11-5016 in the amount of \$228,835.39 to a total budget of \$240,909.25)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-413**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the Water Resources Study**  
2 **Program FY2006 IHS MOA budget 11-5016 with Resolution No. 05-552; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program has provided drilling and professional services**  
4 **to the IHS in the amount of \$228,835.39; and**

5 **WHEREAS, IHS has reimbursed the Water Resources Study Program in the amount of \$228,835.39**  
6 **to the FY2006 IHS MOA budget 11-5016; and**

7 **WHEREAS, this budget amendment has been reviewed by the Legislative Water Resources**  
8 **Committee and the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
10 **authorizes the increase in the amount of \$228,835.39 (IHS reimbursement) to the**  
11 **FY2006 Water Resources Study Program IHS MOA budget 11-5016, for a total of**  
12 **\$240,909.25, in accordance with the budget attached hereto.**

13 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
14 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman, and any designated official**  
15 **are authorized to execute the budget, provided however, that any amendments**  
16 **affecting the funds or funding levels of the budget be submitted for further approval**  
17 **by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
19 **of JUNE, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,273.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
20 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 167.4 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**  
21 **1 (d)(2) & (3) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
22 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
23 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
24 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


