

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Amendment 1 to the Attorney Contract with the Law Firm of DeConcini
McDonald Yetwin & Lacy, P.C. for FY 2006)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-414

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 05-640, the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") entered**
2 **into an Attorney Contract with the law firm of DeConcini McDonald Yetwin & Lacy (the**
3 **"Attorneys") to provide legal representation to the Nation to the Project for fiscal year**
4 **2006; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Center/Museum Project requires continuing legal representation related**
6 **to the construction contract and supplemental agreements for specialized services**
7 **related to security systems, furnishings and other property, and such other matters**
8 **as may be assigned by the Attorney General with the concurrence of the Project**
9 **Administrator; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the foregoing legal services required of the Attorney will exceed the amount of the**
11 **current contract; and**

12 **WHEREAS, attached hereto is Amendment 1 to the current Attorney Contract in the amount of**
13 **\$4,500 for fiscal year 2006; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Center/Museum Project Account 50-1516-810 has sufficient funds to cover**
15 **the amount of the amendment; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation, Domestic Affairs and Budget & Finance Committees**
17 **recommend approval of the Attorney Contract.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

19 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves Amendment 1 to the**
20 **Attorney Contract with the law firm of DeConcini McDonald Yetwin & Lacy in the**
21 **amount of \$4,500, increasing the total contract from \$7,500 to \$12,000 for fiscal**
22 **year 2006, and in the form attached hereto.**

23 **2. Funding of the Attorney Contract shall be provided from the Cultural**
24 **Center/Museum Project budget (Account No. 50-1516-810).**

25 **3. The Chairwoman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney**
26 **Contract.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH Day**
28 **of JUNE, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,273.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
29 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 167.4 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
30 **2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
31 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
33 **Stat. 984).**


