

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Authorizing a One Time Funding (Surplus Funds) in the amount of \$703,792.09**  
**under FY 2006 for the Tohono O'odham Justice Center)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-427**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Justice Center serves the Nation by adjudicating criminal, traffic,**  
2 **children's and civil cases filed before the court within the surrounding boundaries of**  
3 **the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Executive Branch, Treasurer's Office, and the Budget &**  
5 **Finance Committee that a general revenue surplus funds exist for expenditure by the**  
6 **Executive, Legislative, and Judicial Branch; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Justice Center has prepared and presented a budget proposal that identifies**  
8 **program line items determined to have the greatest need particularly line item 750**  
9 **Capital that provides for twenty (20) vehicles that will replace the Justice Center's**  
10 **vehicles exceeding 100,000 miles; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee and Budget and Finance Committee of the Legislative Council**  
12 **of the Tohono O'odham Nation have reviewed this budget and recommends its**  
13 **approval.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**  
15 **authorizes the expenditure of funds identified in the Tohono O'odham Justice Center's**  
16 **One Time Funding (Surplus Funds) proposal in the amount of \$703,792.09 and in**  
17 **accordance with the attached budget.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amount approved and authorized by the Tohono O'odham**  
19 **Legislative Council will not exceed the allocated amount of \$703,792.09.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
21 **Nation's Judicial Official, to wit: the Chief Judge, Deputy Chief Judge and any**  
22 **designated official are authorized to negotiate and administer this budget, provided**  
23 **however, that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the budget as**  
24 **presented shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**  
25 **Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21<sup>ST</sup>, Day**  
27 **of JUNE, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,393.3 FOR; 422.3**  
28 **AGAINST; 625.2 NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
29 **Section 1(d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
30 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






