(Approving and Authorizing for a No-Cost Extension for the Department of Justice-Tribal Resources Grant Program, Grant #2004HEWX0008 for the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department – February 28, 2006)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-480

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) has successfully received**
2 **an award with the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) – Tribal Resources**
3 **Grant Program (TRGP) Equipment Award, funded through the U.S. Department of**
4 **Justice (USDOJ) for the project amount of \$609,343.00 under Grant Award Number**
5 **2004HEWX0008; and**

6 **WHEREAS, TONPD has used these funds specifically for equipment needed; and**

7 **WHEREAS, a remaining balance of \$246,281.54 remains under this grant; and**

8 **WHEREAS, TONPD has requested an no-cost extension with the USDOJ-COPS for the use of these**
9 **remaining funds; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the USDOJ has approved the TONPD request and extended the Grant Period to**
11 **February 28, 2006; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the USDOJ approved this grant continuation with a budget cycle year effective**
13 **September 1, 2004; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the TONPD requests the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council to approve the**
15 **acceptance of this grant extension and authorization to expend the budget in the**
16 **amount of \$246,281.54.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it**
18 **hereby accepts and authorizes the implementation and expenditure of this no-cost**
19 **grant extension and budget of \$246,281.54 for the TRGP Grant #2004HEWX0008; and**
20 **it hereby accepts the extension date effective September 1, 2005 through the**
21 **approved date of February 28, 2006.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that the Chairwoman**
23 **is authorized to accept, negotiate, and execute any documentation associated with**
24 **exercising the acceptance and implementation of agreement.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH Day**
26 **of JULY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,931.1 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
27 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 509.7[11] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
28 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
31 **Stat. 984).**


