

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Resolution No. 06-429, Approving Joinder Agreements for the Arizona Public
Safety Personnel Retirement System, Approving Limited Waivers of Sovereign Immunity
Incident to the Joinder Agreements, and Modifying and Superceding All Prior
Inconsistent Laws)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-481

1 **WHEREAS, resolution No. 06-429 approved the Tohono O'odham Nation's participation in the**
2 **Arizona Public Safety Personnel Retirement System for eligible police officers and**
3 **firefighters and authorized the vice-chairman of the Nation to execute the Joinder**
4 **Agreements; and**


5 **WHEREAS, the Vice-Chairman of the Nation resigned his position before the Joinder Agreements**
6 **were presented to him for execution; and**

7 **WHEREAS, Resolution No. 06-429 should be amended to authorize the Chairwoman of the Nation**
8 **to execute the Joinder Agreements.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby amends**
10 **Resolution No. 06-429 to authorize the Chairwoman of the Nation to execute the two**
11 **Joinder Agreements, which allow the Nations participation in the Arizona Public**
12 **Safety Personnel Retirement System.**

13 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH. Day**
14 **of JULY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 928.0 FOR; 835.7 AGAINST;**
15 **167.4 NOT VOTING; and 509.7[11] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
16 **1 (d) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
17 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
18 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
19 **Stat. 984).**


