

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Intergovernmental Agreement Extending Ending Date with Pima County
and Pima County Flood Control District for Construction of Sells Youth Center
Drain Improvements)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-493

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") has obtained funding through the Pima County**
2 **bond election held on May 18, 2004 for construction of a storm water channeling**
3 **system for the Sells Youth Recreation Center in the amount of One Million Five**
4 **Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000); and**

5 **WHEREAS, Pima County has transmitted the funds to the Nation on a reimbursable basis under**
6 **the terms of an Intergovernmental Agreement negotiated between Pima County, the**
7 **Pima County Flood Control District, and the Nation in the form attached hereto; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the construction of the storm water drainage improvements has been completed**
9 **under the terms of a contract between the Nation and Pace Pacific Construction**
10 **Corporation; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the original IGA was in effect from July 1, 2004 to July 1, 2005; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the term is being amended to read July 1, 2005 to December 31, 2006; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Agreement has been reviewed by the Natural Resources**
14 **Committee, Commerce Committee and the Budget & Finance Committee, which**
15 **recommend approval by the Legislative Council.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
17 **"Intergovernmental Agreement between Pima County, the Pima County Flood Control**
18 **District, and the Tohono O'odham Nation for Construction of the Sells Youth**
19 **Recreation Center Drainage Improvements, Pima County, Arizona" substantially in**
20 **the form attached hereto, namely the term of the Agreement and authorizes the**
21 **Chairwoman of the Nation to execute the Agreement and any future amendments and**
22 **related documents reasonably necessary to close out the project.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH Day**
24 **of JULY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,182.1 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
25 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 258.7[06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
26 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
27 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
29 **Stat. 984).**
