

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2007 Apportionment of Gaming Revenues to Districts by Equal Distribution)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-500

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
2 **Council with broad legislative and fiscal powers, including the power "to manage any**
3 **funds within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation, including proceeds**
4 **derived from lands and resources of the Tohono O'odham Nation" (Constitution,**
5 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

6 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 83-88, "Adoption of Budget and Finance Committee's Plan**
7 **of Operation," the Legislative Council Budget and Finance Committee is delegated the**
8 **power to "review and recommend legislative measures or action to the Legislative**
9 **Council...[regarding] general revenue sharing" (Plan of Operation, Section 1(b)(6)(ii));**
10 **and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has discussed three options for the distribution**
12 **of gaming revenues in accordance with Resolution No. 94-098, as amended, and**
13 **Resolution No. 95-397 as follows: 1) equal distribution; 2) population distribution; and**
14 **3) 50/50 distribution (½ equal and ½ population); and**

15 **WHEREAS, based upon the deletion of the host Districts' 30% share pursuant to paragraph 1.b.(ii)**
16 **of the gaming revenue distribution formula, the Accounting Department has**
17 **calculated the District Allocation as \$17,202,286.22 (Resolution No. 06-496); and**

18 **WHEREAS, the District Allocation is to be apportioned to separate District accounts on August 1**
19 **each year and made available for expenditure subject to budgets approved in**
20 **accordance with Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and Article IX, Section 7 of the Nation's**
21 **Constitution and the additional requirements of Resolution No. 95-397.**


22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
23 **approves and authorizes the FY 2007 apportionment of gaming revenues to the**
24 **Districts by equal distribution.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH Day**
26 **of JULY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,240.1 FOR; 748.2**
27 **AGAINST; 452.5 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Article VI, Section 1 (d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
29 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




