

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the Johnson O'Malley Program FY 2006 Budget Amendment/Modification #3**  
**- Account #10-1210)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-502**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Johnson O'Malley Program provides**  
2 **supplemental financial assistance to support those programs in public schools**  
3 **designed to meet the specialized and unique educational needs of eligible Native**  
4 **American students enrolled at Indian Oasis/Baboquivari Unified School District, Gila**  
5 **Bend Unified School District and the Tohono O'odham Nation Division of Early**  
6 **Childhood Development; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Johnson O'Malley Program FY 2006 Budget Amendment/Modification #3 reflects**  
8 **reducing line items 650 (Travel & Registration), 660 (Travel Expense), 720 (Office**  
9 **Supplies), 721 (Program Supplies), 730 (Dues & Subscriptions), 774 (Computer**  
10 **Maintenance), 812 (Public Relations); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the FY 2006 Johnson O'Malley Program Amendment/Modification #3 increases line**  
12 **item 860 (Special Activities) and the 900 (Indirect Cost); and**

13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2006 Johnson O'Malley Program Amendment/Modification #3 has been**  
14 **reviewed and approved by the Human Resources Development Committee and Budget**  
15 **and Finance Committee.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
17 **Johnson O'Malley Program Amendment/Modification #3 as attached hereto which**  
18 **reflects reducing line items, 650 (Travel & Registration), 660 (Travel Expense), 720**  
19 **(Office Supplies), 721 (Program Supplies), 730 (Dues & Subscriptions), 774 (Computer**  
20 **Maintenance), and increases line item 860 Special Activities and 900 Indirect Cost.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Chairwoman is hereby authorized to**  
22 **negotiate and execute the budget provided that any amendment affecting the funding**  
23 **or funding levels of the budget shall be submitted for approval by the Tohono**  
24 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
26 **of JULY, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,247.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
27 **193.8 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f)**  
28 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
29 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
30 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


