## **RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**

(Amending Resolution No. 06-500, "Approving FY 2007 Apportionment of Gaming Revenues to Districts by Equal Distribution," to Clarify FY 2007 District Apportionment Amounts)

### **RESOLUTION NO.** <u>06-509</u>

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham Legislative
2		Council with the power "to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the
3		Tohono O'odham Nation, including proceeds derived from lands and resources of the
4		Tohono O'odham Nation" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(d)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council has exercised its fiscal and legislative powers by adopting a
6		formula for the distribution of the Nation's gaming revenues ("Formula") pursuant to
7		Resolution No. 94-098, "Authorizing Gaming Revenue Distribution Formula," as
8		amended; and
9	WHEREAS,	paragraph 1.b.(i) and (ii) of the Formula provide that 70% of "all revenues from Gaming
10		Facilities paid to the Nation" are allocated as follows: 70% to the Nation's general fund
11		and 30% to the Districts (the "District Allocation") (Resolution No. 94-098, as amended);
12		and
13	WHEREAS,	paragraph 1.b.(ii)(A) of the Formula provides that "Thirty (30%) of the District
14		Allocation shall be allocated to the District where the Gaming Facility which generated
15		such revenue is located" (the "Host District Share"); and
16	WHEREAS,	paragraph 1.b.(ii)(B) of the Formula provides that the remainder of the District
17		Allocation (after allocating the Host District Share) "shall be divided among all 11
18		Districts of the Nation" in accordance with the allocation formula established by the
19		Legislative Council (Resolution No. 95-397); and
20	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Accounting Department calculates the District Allocation based upon the
21		gaming revenues in the year prior to August 1, although the final District Allocation
22		amount varies based upon accrued interest and actual revenues for the months of
23		June and July; and
24	WHEREAS,	the Accounting Department has calculated that the total District Allocation to be
25		allocation on August 1, 2006 as \$17,202,286.22, subject to final adjustments; and
26	WHEREAS,	on July 18, 2006, the Legislative Council adopted Resolution No. 06-496 to delete the
27		Host District Share from the Formula; and
28	WHEREAS,	the Accounting Department calculated that, if the Formula amendment adopted by
29		Resolution No. 06-496 had become effective, each District would have received an FY
30		2007 apportionment of approximately \$1,563,844.20; and

1	WHEREAS, during the debate following the passage of Resolution No. 06-496, spreadsheets were	
2	distributed to the Legislative Council that reflected the projected District	
3	apportionment of \$1,563,844.20 per District based upon the Formula amendment; and	
4	WHEREAS, the Legislative Council subsequently passed Resolution No. 06-500, "Approving FY 2007	
5	Apportionment of Gaming Revenues to Districts by Equal Distribution," and thereby	
6	approved and authorized "the FY 2007 apportionment of gaming revenues to the	
7	Districts by equal distribution"; and	
8	WHEREAS, the Formula amendment adopted by the Legislative Council by Resolution No. 06-496	
9	was vetoed on July 21, 2006 and, on July 24, 2006, the resolution to override the veto	
10	failed (Resolution No. 06-506); and	
11	WHEREAS, for this reason, the existing Formula remains in effect for the District Allocation to be	
12	apportioned on August 1, 2006; and	
13	WHEREAS, as a result, the FY 2007 apportionment of the District Allocation under the current	
14	Formula (after allocating the Host District Share) will result in an apportionment of	
15	\$1,094,690.94 per District, subject to final adjustments based on accrued interest and	
16	actual gaming revenues; and	
17	WHEREAS, it is in the Nation's best interest to amend Resolution No. 06-500 to identify the Host	
18	District Share amounts and the District Allocation for each District as reflected in the	
19	flowchart titled "Preliminary Gaming Distribution to Districts For Fiscal Year 2007	
20	(Equal Distribution)."	
21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that Resolution	
22	No. 06-500 is hereby amended as follows:	
23	(1) the fourth whereas clause in Resolution No. 06-500 shall be deleted and replaced	
24	to read as follows:	
25	"WHEREAS, the Accounting Department has calculated the total District	
26	Allocation as \$17,202,286.22, which, subject to final adjustments based on	
27	accrued interest and actual gaming revenues, will result in the following FY 2007	
28	allocations in accordance with the "Preliminary Gaming Distribution to Districts	
29	For Fiscal Year 2007 (Equal Distribution)" flowchart dated 7/18/2006:	
30	(1) Hickiwan Host District Share of \$13,701.53.	
31	(2) San Xavier Host District Share of \$4,275,484.43.	

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1	(3) the remainder of the District Allocation (after allocating the Host District
2	Share) to be divided equally among all 11 Districts of the Nation of
3	\$1,094,690.94 for each District."
4	(2) an additional clause shall be added immediately following the first resolved
5	clause of Resolution No. 06-500 as follows:
6	"BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the
7	"Preliminary Gaming Distribution to Districts For Fiscal Year 2007 (Equal
8	Distribution)" flowchart is incorporated by this reference and is adopted as a
9	basis for allocating and apportioning the FY 2007 District Allocation, provided
10	that the Accounting Department is authorized, in accordance with this
11	Resolution, Resolution No. 94-098, as amended, and Resolution No. 95-397, and
12	after consulting with the Budget and Finance Committee, to make final
13	adjustments to the amounts therein, based on accrued interest and actual
14	gaming revenues."
15	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
16	Legislative Budget and Finance and Commerce Committees, with the Office of the
17	Chairwoman and in consultation with the Accounting Department, to
18	(1) consult with the San Xavier and Hickiwan Districts concerning reductions in the
19	Host District Share portion of the Formula and increased allocations to all the
20	Nation's Districts under paragraph 1.b.(ii)(B) of the Formula.
21	(2) make a written request to the San Xavier and Hickiwan Districts by August 4, 2006
22	for all records necessary to conduct such consultations.
23	(3) conclude such consultations and submit a draft resolution to the Legislative
24	Council during the September 2006 general session to amend the Formula in the
25	manner described herein.
26	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>27<sup>TH.</sup></u> Day
27 28	of <u>JULY, 2006</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,611.5</u> FOR; <u>829.3</u> AGAINST; <u>-0-</u> NOT VOTING; and <u>[02]</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
20 29	Acticle VI, Section 1 (d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
30	Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
31	Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
32	18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
