

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorizing a Change in Scope for the 12% Distribution Grant Agreement for the  
Arivaca Volunteer Fire Department)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-532**

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 05-647, the Tohono O'odham Nation's (the "Nation") approved a**  
2 **new tribal-state gaming compact (the "Compact") with the State of Arizona; and**

3 **WHEREAS, as part of Section 12 of the Compact, the Nation did agree to make certain tribal**  
4 **contributions in consideration for substantial exclusivity covenants by the State;**  
5 **and**

6 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 12(d) of the Compact the Nation agreed to contribute twelve**  
7 **percent of the tribal contribution (the "12% Distribution") to cities, towns, and**  
8 **counties, for government services that benefit the general public; and**

9 **WHEREAS, through Resolution 05-647, the Legislative Council did approve final agreements for**  
10 **the Nation's fiscal year 2005 12% Distribution, including one grant to the Arivaca**  
11 **Volunteer Fire Department, through Pima County, in the amount of \$25,000.00; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the original purpose for the grant was to purchase from the Arivaca Community**  
13 **Center the land on which the Volunteer Fire Department facility currently sits,**  
14 **however the Arivaca Community Center has subsequently declined to sell the land;**  
15 **and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Arivaca Volunteer Fire Department could make other use of the funds, including**  
17 **payments for an ambulance gurney, security system costs, diesel delivery, and self-**  
18 **contained breathing apparatuses for the firefighters; and**

19 **WHEREAS, if the scope for the grant is changed, the Arivaca Volunteer Fire Department will**  
20 **need additional time to accept and expend the funding.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
22 **a change in the scope of the grant awarded to the Arivaca Volunteer Fire Department**  
23 **to allow for the funding to be used for the following purposes:**

- 24 **- payments for an automatic lift ambulance gurney**
- 25 **- payments for the Fire Department alarm system**
- 26 **- payments for delivery of diesel fuel**
- 27 **- purchase of self contained breathing apparatuses for the fire fighters**

1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby authorizes  
2 an extension of the time in which the Arivaca Volunteer Fire Department may accept,  
3 and Pima County may make available, the grant funding until December 31, 2006.

4 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09<sup>TH</sup> Day  
5 of AUGUST, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,078.0 FOR; -0-  
6 AGAINST; 362.8 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
7 Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the  
8 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
9 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
10 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


