

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the FY 2007 PHASE ONE Tribal Child Welfare Budget for Division of**  
**Child Welfare Services)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-534**

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 06-210, the Legislative Council approved allocation of \$74,657.98 for**  
2 **the FY2007 Tribal Child Welfare Budget, Account No. 01-1442, for the Department of**  
3 **Health and Human Services, Division of Child Welfare Services; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Division of Child Welfare Services has demonstrated in its Child Welfare Master**  
5 **Plan the critical needs for additional Child Welfare and Family Preservation resources**  
6 **to better serve the children and families of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY2007 PHASE ONE Tribal Child Welfare Budget reflects the first step toward**  
8 **meeting these critical needs for additional resources to better serve the children and**  
9 **families of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

10 **WHEREAS, by approval of the Nation's Executive Office and Legislative Council Committees, the**  
11 **Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Child Welfare Services**  
12 **presents the attached FY2007 PHASE ONE Tribal Child Welfare Budget, a one time**  
13 **funding in the amount of \$1,375,906.67, from Tribal surplus funding, for the**  
14 **Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Child Welfare Services, for the**  
15 **period of October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**  
17 **approve and authorize the Executive Branch to expend funds for the attached FY2007**  
18 **PHASE ONE Tribal Child Welfare Budget, effective October 1, 2006 through September**  
19 **30, 2007, a one time funding, in the amount of \$1,375,906.67, which is hereby**  
20 **appropriated from Tribal surplus funding, for the Department of Health and Human**  
21 **Services, Division of Child Welfare Services.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials to wit: the Chairwoman and**  
23 **any designated official are hereby authorized to expend the funds, provided however,**  
24 **that any budget amendments affecting the funding levels shall be submitted for prior**  
25 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
27 **of AUGUST, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**  
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
29 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
30 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
31 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
32 **Stat. 984).**






