

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Emergency Repair Construction Budget for Storm Damaged Homes)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-539

1 **WHEREAS, the monsoon is seasonal weather which is accompanied with high winds, hail and**
2 **thunderstorms; and**

3 **WHEREAS, such weather creates hazards and havoc to the property of the Tohono O'odham; and**

4 **WHEREAS, in order to address the damages caused by the storms there is a need to set aside**
5 **funds to hire personnel to provide the repairs and renovations for such homes; and**


6 **WHEREAS, the Executive Office has submitted a budget attached to provide such emergency**
7 **services to the Tohono Oodham members in the amount of \$ 24,533.40.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono Oodham Legislative Council does hereby**
9 **appropriate \$ 24,533.40 in one-time funding from the Tribal Surplus funds for the**
10 **Emergency Repair Construction budget for storm damaged homes, in accordance with**
11 **the budget attached hereto; which is hereby approved; provided that any amendments**
12 **affecting the funds or funding levels of the budget shall be submitted for further prior**
13 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

14 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a periodic up date report be submitted to the Tohono O'odham**
15 **Legislative Council and the Executive Office upon completion of the emergency**
16 **repair/renovation projects.**

17 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day**
18 **of AUGUST, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**
19 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 04 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
20 **Article VI, Section 1 (c)(2)(d)(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
21 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
22 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
23 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


