

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Accepting a Basic Library Services Grant (No. NG-05-06-0009-06) for the Venito Garcia Library and Archives from the Institute of Museum and Library Services)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-563

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has historically supported the Venito Garcia  
2 Library and Archives, the library agency for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

3 WHEREAS, the Venito Garcia Library and Archives is charged with library development for the  
4 Tohono O'odham Nation; and

5 WHEREAS, the Venito Garcia Library and Archives has received this grant annually since 2000  
6 from IMLS (Institute of Museum and Library Services, the primary library funding  
7 agency of the U.S. Federal government) through its Native American Library Services  
8 division; and

9 WHEREAS, this grant has been received (as per attached letter to Chairwoman Juan-Saunders  
10 from Anne-Imelda M. Radice, dated 19 June 2006).

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and  
12 approves the Basic Grant from IMLS for library services and supplies (grant number  
13 NG-05-06-0009-06) for the period from October 1, 2006 until September 30, 2007 and  
14 authorizes use of these funds for the amount of \$6,000 according to the attached  
15 budget.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council waives indirect costs  
17 which is a requirement of this grant.

18 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman and  
19 any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,  
20 provided, however, that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the  
21 grant shall be submitted for further approval.

22 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22<sup>ND</sup> Day  
23 of AUGUST, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-  
24 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
25 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
26 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
27 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
28 Stat. 984).




