

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing FY 2007 Expenditures from the SAWRSA Trust Fund for Continuation of Efforts to Complete Tribal Responsibilities and Obligations Related to Utilization of Central Arizona Project Water and Irrigation Systems)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-590

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, by means of Resolution No. 99-334,
2 authorized and directed the completion of tribal responsibilities and obligations
3 related to construction of facilities for utilization of Central Arizona Project water and
4 irrigation systems in the eastern Schuk Toak District; and

5 WHEREAS, portions of work identified for FY 2006 were not completed and are being budgeted for
6 in FY 2007 as reflected in the attached budget and justification; and

7 WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office submitted the attached budget and justification for FY 2007
8 to continue the scope of work authorized under Resolution No. 99-334 for an amount
9 of \$159,984.29; and

10 WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office requests from the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council,
11 approval of funding from the SAWRSA Trust Fund to enable completion of tribal
12 responsibilities and obligations related to utilization of Central Arizona Project water
13 and irrigation systems in the eastern Schuk Toak District.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
15 approves the funding request and authorizes the expenditures in the amount of
16 \$159,984.29 to complete tasks indicated in the attached budget for the fiscal year 2007.

17 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$159,984.29 are hereby appropriated from
18 the SAWRSA Trust Fund to cover expenditures during the period from October 1, 2006
19 through September 30, 2007.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day
21 of SEPTEMBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,242.3 FOR; 836.4
22 AGAINST; 362.1 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
23 Article VI, Section 1 (i) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
24 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
25 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
26 Stat. 984).
