

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the FY 2006 Pisinemo District Continuing Authorization for the Period of**  
**October 1, 2006 through October 31, 2006)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-601**

1 **WHEREAS, the current fiscal year expires on September 30, 2006 upon which the authority of the**  
2 **Pisinemo District to expend appropriated funds shall also cease; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District Council is continuing to examine the fiscal requirements of all**  
4 **operations, projects and services; and**

5 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Legislative Council to enact the necessary authority to**  
6 **permit Pisinemo District to continue use of funds budgeted for operations, projects**  
7 **and services beyond September 30, 2006.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
9 **a Continuing Resolution for Pisinemo District's FY 2006 budget and that there are**  
10 **sufficient funds within the Pisinemo District FY 2006 budget to cover expenditures**  
11 **beyond September 30, 2006.**

12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all employees compensation shall remain at current levels until**  
13 **such time that the District's fiscal year 2007 budget is formally adopted and authorizes**  
14 **any necessary employment compensation adjustments to be retroactive to October**  
15 **1, 2006.**

16 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Continuing Resolution will stay in effect until the Pisinemo**  
17 **District presents its FY 2007 Budget to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for**  
18 **review and approval.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
20 **of SEPTEMBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**  
21 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
22 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
23 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
24 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
25 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
