

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Resolution No. 06-612 and Approving the Department of Health and Human Services FY 2006 Tribal Children's Home Program Budget Amendment #2, Account No. 01-1305)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-661

1 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 06-612, the Legislative Council approved the Department of
2 **Health and Human Services FY 2006 Tribal Children's Home Budget Amendment #1,**
3 **in the following amounts:**

8 **WHEREAS,** the Nation was notified of BIA Contract Modification No. 21 which increased an
9 **additional \$100,000.00 for BIA WAG funds allocated, which had not been previously**
10 **budgeted; and**

11 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Health and Human Services has developed and obtained
12 **Committee approval for utilizing Tribal Gaming Savings in the attached FY 2006**
13 **Tribal Children's Home Program Budget Amendment #2, which decreases salaries**
14 **and fringe benefits cost-shares, and thereby decreases and recovers \$100,000.00**
15 **Tribal funding to carry-forward along with any unspent balance of this budget, to**
16 **be effective October 1, 2005 through September 30, 2006, in the following amounts:**

23 **Children's Home Program Budget Amendment #2 attached, which decreases**
24 **salaries and fringe benefit cost-shares, effective October 1, 2005 through September**
25 **30, 2006, inclusive of budget modifications during this period, in the following**

1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Nation shall spend all related FY 2006 BIA WAG funding first
2 before related Tribal funding in the above program budget, and shall replace any
3 Tribal funds spent from the above program budgets whenever FY 2006 BIA WAG
4 funds are available.

5 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve and
6 authorize the Executive Branch to carry-forward the FY 2006 Tribal funding of
7 \$100,000.00 recovered after this budget amendment and the unspent balance of
8 this Tribal budget amendment, in order to meet the BIA WAG requirements of
9 serving the Tohono O'odham Nation, provided however, that the Executive Branch
10 shall present to the Districts first for prior consideration of any additional requests
11 of Desert Diamond Gaming Savings desired to meet the BIA WAG requirements of
12 serving the Tohono O'odham Nation, before submitting these requests to the
13 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

14 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials to wit: the Chairwoman and
15 any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate, execute and expend the
16 grant.

17 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 28TH. Day**
18 **of SEPTEMBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,742.2 FOR; -0-**
19 **AGAINST; 505.5 NOT VOTING; and 193.1[07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
20 **by Section 1 (d)(2)&(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**
21 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
22 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
23 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
