7		requires the Authority to submit for prior review and approval of the Legislative
8		Council and each affected District any proposed utility easement; and
9	WHEREAS,	TOUA requests permission for a Sanitary Sewerline Right-of-Way and related facilities and related facilities for a Sanitary Sewerline Right-of-Way And Righ-of-Way And Right-of-Way
10		to accommodate three homes identified with Public Law 86-121 funding, San Xavier
11		District, Tohono O'odham Nation; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Sanitary Sewerline Right-of-Way consists of Parcel "A" which is 1,204.11 feet in
13		length x 50 feet in width which encompasses 1.38 acres more or less; and
14	WHEREAS,	$TOUA \ has respectfully submitted \ all \ documents \ and \ pertinent \ information (attached)$
15		here to and incorporated here in by reference) for uses consistent with the authorized
16		purposes of TOUA; and
17	WHEREAS,	the TOUA San Xavier Community Sanitary Sewerline Right-of-Way and related
18		facilities will be of substantial benefit to the San Xavier Community, San Xavier
19		District, the Tohono O'odham Nation and their respective members; and
20	WHEREAS,	the San Xavier District's Housing Committee reviewed and approved the requested
21		Right-of-Way on August 23, 2006 and recommended approval thereof by the San
22		Xavier District Council; and
23	WHEREAS,	the San Xavier District Council approved the proposed Right-of-Way on September
24		05, 2006 with enactment of District Council Resolution No. SXDC 09-06-04; and
25	WHEREAS,	TOUA personnel presented and reviewed this project with the San Xavier District's
26		Planning Committee on September 06, 2006 for further support and approval; and
27	WHEREAS,	the Natural Resources Committee did review the supporting documents and scope
28		of work on October 02, 2006 and by consensus recommends approval thereof by the
29		Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
