

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Endorsing Congressional Candidate Mr. Raul Grijalva for United States Congress)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-686

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of Tohono O'odham Nation  
2 members participating in the electoral process as citizens of the United States of  
3 America; and

4 WHEREAS, the democratic candidate and incumbent Congressman Raul Grijalva has been  
5 supportive of tribal governments while serving on the Pima County Board of  
6 Supervisors and presently as a United States House Representative for Congressional  
7 District 7 that is the only U.S. Congressional District to represent seven separate  
8 Native American tribes that includes the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

9 WHEREAS, as a U.S. Congressman for the past 4 years, Mr. Raul Grijalva has demonstrated his  
10 respect for government-to-government relationship between the federal government  
11 and tribal governments, specifically with the Tohono O'odham Nation on issues  
12 relating to homeland security, education and healthcare; and

13 WHEREAS, as a U.S. Congressman, Mr. Raul Grijalva pledges his continued desire to maintain  
14 and enhance the relationship between the Tohono O'odham Nation and his office.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby endorses  
16 congressional candidate Mr. Raul Grijalva for United States Congress, District 7.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup>. Day  
18 of OCTOBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-  
19 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
20 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
21 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
22 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
23 Stat. 984).


