

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting a "NO" vote on Proposition 200 in the 2006 State Elections)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-696

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of Tohono O'odham Nation**
2 **members participating in the electoral process as citizens of the United States of**
3 **America; and**

4 **WHEREAS, Proposition 200 Establishes \$1,000,000 prize for randomly selected voter who votes**
5 **in primary or general election; establishes funding source of 20% of unclaimed**
6 **lottery prize money; creates Arizona Voter Reward Commission and Fund and**
7 **criteria for selecting winners in a public drawing; required commission**
8 **sponsorship of nonpartisan voter registration and turnout events; and**

9 **WHEREAS, if approved Proposition 200 will automatically enter every voter in a primary or**
10 **general election into a lottery with a first prize of one million dollars or more; and**

11 **WHEREAS, a "yes" vote shall have the effect of establishing a \$1,000,000 lottery for voters who**
12 **vote in the primary or general elections that would be funded by a percentage of**
13 **unclaimed state lottery prize money and creating the Arizona Voter Reward**
14 **Commission and Fund; and**

15 **WHEREAS, this measure disregards the importance of individuals to vote during elections as**
16 **a privilege, responsibility and exercise of citizenship.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby supports**
18 **a "NO" vote on Proposition 200.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day**
20 **of OCTOBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,538.4 FOR; -0-**
21 **AGAINST; 733.4 NOT VOTING; and 169.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
22 **by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
23 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
24 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
25 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
