

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
(Supporting a "YES" vote on Proposition 202 in the 2006 State Elections)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-697

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of Tohono O'odham Nation  
2 members participating in the electoral process as citizens of the United States of  
3 America; and

4 WHEREAS, Proposition 202 raises minimum wage to \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2007,  
5 with certain exceptions; provides yearly annual cost of living increases; requires  
6 that employers post notice about employee rights; establishes penalties and  
7 permits private lawsuits and enforcement by the industrial commission; and

8 WHEREAS, a "yes" vote shall have the effect of raising the minimum wage to \$6.75 per hour with  
9 certain exceptions beginning January 1, 2007, providing for yearly minimum wage  
10 cost of living increases, requiring employers to post notice about employee  
11 minimum wage rights, establishing penalties for violations of the law and  
12 permitting private lawsuits to enforce the law.

13 WHEREAS, this measure will positively impact the Tohono O'odham Nations members who  
14 receive a minimum wage under the state.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby supports  
16 a "YES" vote on Proposition 202.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup>. Day  
18 of OCTOBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-  
19 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
20 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
21 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
22 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
23 Stat. 984).




