

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting a "YES" vote on Proposition 203 in the 2006 State Elections)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-698

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of Tohono O'odham Nation**
2 **members participating in the electoral process as citizens of the United States of**
3 **America; and**

4 **WHEREAS, Proposition 203 establishes early childhood development and health board and**
5 **fund by increasing the state tax on tobacco products; monies distributed locally to**
6 **benefit children up to five years of age and their families; creates regional**
7 **partnership councils to identify local needs and distributes monies based on**
8 **region, population, and income; and**

9 **WHEREAS, a "YES" vote shall have the effect of [1] establishing an early childhood development**
10 **health care board and fund, [2] increasing the state tax of cigarettes (.80**
11 **cents/pack), cigars and other tobacco products, [3] establishing regional**
12 **partnership councils throughout the state to identify childhood development and**
13 **health services needs at the local level and [4] distributing monies and grants to**
14 **eligible programs that serve children up to five years of age and their families; and**

15 **WHEREAS, this measure may benefit directly and indirectly by a "YES" vote on Proposition 203.**


16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby supports**
17 **a "YES" vote on Proposition 203.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH. Day**
19 **of OCTOBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**
20 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
21 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
22 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
23 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
24 **Stat. 984).**




