

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
(Supporting a "NO" vote on Proposition 205 in the 2006 State Elections)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-699

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of Tohono O'odham Nation**  
2 **members participating in the electoral process as citizens of the United States of**  
3 **America; and**

4 **WHEREAS, Proposition 205 requires ballots to be mailed to every voter automatically and all**  
5 **elections be conducted by mail; eliminates polling places in each precinct; restricts**  
6 **use of polling places to minimum number of countywide locations other than**  
7 **school buildings; provides ballots be mailed with prepaid envelopes; repeals**  
8 **sample ballots; retains early voting laws; and**

9 **WHEREAS, a "YES" vote shall have the effect of requiring a ballot be mailed to every registered**  
10 **voter and all elections be conducted by mail-in-ballot, eliminating polling places**  
11 **in each precinct, restricting the use of polling places to a minimum number of**  
12 **countywide locations other than school buildings, and repealing the sample ballot**  
13 **requirement while retaining current early ballot laws; and**

14 **WHEREAS, this measure will have a negative impact on elders and Nation's members who only**  
15 **communicate in O'odham as this will eliminate assistance provided by poll workers**  
16 **at polling places and may have adverse affect on voters on the Nation who are in**  
17 **rural areas and travel for miles to receive mail.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby supports**  
19 **a "NO" vote on Proposition 205.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup>, Day**  
21 **of OCTOBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 813.2 FOR; 800.45**  
22 **AGAINST; 827.15 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
23 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
24 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
25 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
26 **Stat. 984).**




