7	WHEREAS,	continued representation is necessary to protect the Nation's interests in these							
8		proceedings; and							
9	WHEREAS,	the Attorney General has proposed an Attorney Contract with California Indian Legal							
10		Services for Fiscal Year 2007, for the period October 1, 2006 to September 30, 2007, in							
11	the amount of \$100,000, a copy of which is attached hereto; and								
12	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs and Budget & Finance Committees recommend approval by the							
13		Legislative Council of an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms.							
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:								
15		1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney Contract							
16	with California Indian Legal Services in the amount of \$100,000 for Fiscal Year								
17		2007, for the period October 1, 2006 to September 30, 2007, in the form attached							
18	hereto.								
19		2. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided from the operating budget							
20		of the Office of Attorney General.							
21		3. The Chairwoman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney							
22		Contract.
