

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2007 Administrative Lobby Provisions Budget Amendment #1 and
Appropriating an Additional \$60,000.00 in Surplus Funds)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-713

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has approved the Executive Branch Fiscal**
2 **Year 2007 budgets, including the Administrative Lobby Provisions Budget No. 01-3002**
3 **in the amount of \$684,000.00 (Resolution No. 06-210); and**

4 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 05-651, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved**
5 **an attorney contract with the lobbying firm of Holland & Knight LLP, which was**
6 **funded by; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Appropriations Committee and the Office of the Chairwoman recommend**
8 **extending the attorney contract with Holland & Knight through FY 2007 and**
9 **authorizing Holland & Knight to provide additional services to the Tohono O'odham**
10 **Nation; and**

11 **WHEREAS, additional services will increase the funds necessary to fund the FY 2007 Holland &**
12 **Knight contract; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Appropriations Committee and the Office of the Chairwoman are therefore**
14 **requesting an increase of \$60,000.00 to line item 811 in the FY 2007 Administrative**
15 **Lobby Provisions Budget No. 01-3002 to cover additional costs.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby (1)**
17 **appropriates an additional \$60,000.00 from surplus funds of the Tohono O'odham**
18 **Nation for the FY 2007 Administrative Lobby Provisions Budget No. 01-3002 line item**
19 **811 and (2) accordingly approves the FY 2007 Administrative Lobby Provisions Budget**
20 **Amendment #1, which will increase the total budget amount from \$684,000.00 to**
21 **\$744,000.00.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
23 **Nation's Chairwoman and any designated official are authorized to administer the**
24 **FY 2007 Administrative Lobby Provisions Budget, provided, however, that any**
25 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the Budget shall be submitted**
26 **for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

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1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day
2 of OCTOBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,271.8 FOR; -0-
3 AGAINST; 169.0 NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
4 Section 1 (d)(2)&(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
5 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
6 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
7 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
