

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Budget Amendment #1 to Carryover \$61,390.00 from FY2006 01-1021
Department of Information and Technology Budget to FY2007 01-1021 Department
of Information and Technology Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-719

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY2007 Administrative**
2 **Support Offices (ASO) - Department of Information and Technology's Budget**
3 **pursuant to Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 06-210; and**

4 **WHEREAS, line item 660 TRAVEL EXPENSES reflects a carryover amount of \$5,240.00 for costs**
5 **associated with travel expenses; and**

6 **WHEREAS, line item 810 PROFESSIONAL SERVICES reflects a carryover amount of \$56,150.00 for**
7 **costs associated for Professional services and training for a total budget amount of**
8 **\$61,390.00; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the FY07 ASO - Department of Information and Technology 01-1021 Budget**
10 **Amendment #1 has been reviewed by the Budget and Finance Committee; and**

11 **WHEREAS, due to revisions on contracts for a reduced cost, a full schedule and scheduling**
12 **conflicts, Spectrum HR Systems was unable to provide training and on-site services**
13 **to the Nation until the 4th week in October 2006, which has been scheduled and set for**
14 **October 23, 24, 25, of 2006. Spectrum requires an implementation analysis and**
15 **planning visit which is essential to a successful implementation of iVantage, a human**
16 **resource management system.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
18 **re-authorizing of un-expended funds from the Tohono O'odham Nation FY 2006**
19 **Budget in the amount of \$61,390.00 into the FY 2007 Budget from October 1, 2006**
20 **through September 30, 2007 on a one time basis in order to complete all projects; and**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
22 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman and any designated official are authorized**
23 **to administer the budget, provided however, that any amendments affecting the**
24 **funds or funding levels of the budget shall be submitted for further prior approval by**
25 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH. Day**
27 **of OCTOBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,793.3 FOR; -0-**
28 **AGAINST; 647.5 NOT VOTING; and [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
30 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


