

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services - Division  
of Behavioral Health FY2007 Utilizing Revenue Budget-Account No. 18-1429)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-731**

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health is**  
2 **currently operating the Behavioral Health Division through an Indian Health**  
3 **Services (I.H.S.) 638 Contract. The Seriously Mentally Ill (SMI) Program is a**  
4 **comprehensive Day Treatment Program for Seriously Mentally Ill and**  
5 **Developmental Disabled Adults, services which includes educational sessions on**  
6 **general mental health and substance abuse, community activities, work projects,**  
7 **and case management. The original SMI funds from the I.H.S. grant ended on**  
8 **August 31, 1990; and**

9 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 99-500, the Department of Health**  
10 **and Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health, SMI Program has been**  
11 **collecting third party reimbursement funds since September 1999 from the State**  
12 **of Arizona and has since accumulated funds; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Division of Behavioral Health, has accumulated funds to cover the Third Party**  
14 **Revenue Budget Account No. 18-1429 in the amount of \$156,769.74 for FY07**  
15 **operational expenses (October, 01 2006 to September 30, 2007); and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Behavioral Health Division request**  
17 **to continue to cost share the Project Administrator position at 25% or \$13,202.09**  
18 **from October 1, 2006 to September 30, 2007 and fringe benefits to reflect the salary.**  
19 **Cost share with MOH 50% and HOPP 25% to work and complete our SMI modular**  
20 **project and future projects as needed for the development of services provided to**  
21 **the Nation; and**

22 **WHEREAS, any future funds generated will be used for program staff support expenses, i.e.,**  
23 **insurance, utilities, communication, supplies, repair and maintenance for vehicles,**  
24 **equipment and building; food; gas, oil and coolants; client support and special**  
25 **medical services; and**

26 **WHEREAS, a Third Party Revenue budget in the amount of \$156,769.74 for FY2007, has been**  
27 **submitted for review and approval by the Department of Health and Human**  
28 **Services for the Division of Behavioral Health.**

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
**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 1. The attached FY2007 Third Party Revenue Budget in the amount of \$156,769.74 to supplement the FY2007 Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health Budget is hereby approved to expend such funds in an amount not to exceed \$156,769.74 to supplement the Division of Behavioral Health FY2007 budgets.**
- 2. The FY2007 Division of Behavioral Health Third Party Revenue Budget to be retroactive to October 1, 2006.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman and any designated official are authorized to negotiate and execute the revenue budget, provided however, that any amendments/modifications affecting the funds or funding levels of the revenue budget shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20<sup>TH</sup> Day of OCTOBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,271.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 169.9 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


