

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting December 12-13, 2006 Special Session for an "Executive Education Seminar on Nation Building: Leadership, Governance, & Economic Policy" by the Native Nations Institute)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 06-736

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and procedures**
2 **to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees,**
3 **boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
4 **Article VI, Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vest the Council**
6 **with the authority to, "by majority vote, call for a Special Session" (Legislative Rules**
7 **of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.2.); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Administration and Commerce Committee have jointly requested**
9 **a special session to be set on December 12-13, 2006, for an "Executive Education**
10 **Seminar on Nation Building: Leadership, Governance, & Economic Policy" by the**
11 **Native Nations Institute.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby sets a**
13 **special session on December 12-13, 2006, for an "Executive Education Seminar on**
14 **Nation Building: Leadership, Governance, & Economic Policy" by the Native Nations**
15 **Institute at a facility suitable to accommodate all participants.**

16 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 23RD. Day of**
17 **OCTOBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,271.80 FOR; -0-**
18 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 169.0 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
19 **Article VI Section 1 (a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
20 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
21 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
22 **Stat. 984).**
