3	WHEREAS,	as part of Section 12 of the Compact, the Nation did agree to make certain triba
4		contributions in consideration for substantial exclusivity covenants by the State; and
5	WHEREAS.	for fiscal year 2006, the Nation was not able to award its entire 12% Distribution
6	,	through direct grants, but instead transferred some of the funding to the Commerce
7		and Economic Development Commission to hold until further direction from the
8		Nation; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee of the Legislative Council and the Chairwoman of the
10		Nation jointly recommend approval of the following grantees for the designated
11		purposes and in the specified amounts.
12	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nation requests that the Commerce and Economic
13		Development Commission provide a grant, from the 12% Distribution monies that are
14		held by the State of Arizona for the Nation, to the following recipients for the
15		designated purposes and specified amounts:
16		1. Ajo Ambulance - \$200,000.00: to purchase two new ambulances to add to its fleet
17		2. <u>Steele Children's Research Center, the University of Arizona - \$190,000:</u> to fund
18		research that will use a mouse model to investigate the effects of fish-oil as a
19		natural therapy to prevent and improve Type 2 diabetes mellitus.
