

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approve Time Extension for Fiscal Year 2005 12% Grant Recipients)

RESOLUTION NO. 06-751

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 02-562, the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") approved a new**
2 **tribal-state gaming compact (the "Compact") with the State of Arizona; and**
3 **WHEREAS, as part of Section 12 of the Compact, the Nation did agree to make certain tribal**
4 **contributions in consideration for substantial exclusivity covenants by the State; and**
5 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 12(d), the Nation has entered into grant agreements with various**
6 **entities, including the Town of Oro Valley and the Southern Arizona Aids Foundation**
7 **during fiscal year 2005; and**
8 **WHEREAS, both the Town of Oro Valley and the Southern Arizona Aids Foundation have**
9 **requested extensions of their grants.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council approves extensions of the fiscal**
11 **year 2005 grants awarded to the following recipients for the length of time specified:**

- 12 **1. The Town of Oro Valley - one 12 month extension, through October 21, 2007; to**
13 **provide additional time for the construction of the wall and a fence around the**
14 **Honey Bee Village preserve.**
- 15 **2. Southern Arizona Aids Foundation - one approximately 8 month extension,**
16 **through June 1, 2007; to provide additional time for the Voz, an HIV/AIDS and**
17 **substance abuse prevention program targeted at youth.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH Day**
19 **of NOVEMBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**
20 **AGAINST; -0-NOT VOTING; and [09]ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
21 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
22 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
23 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
24 **Stat. 984).**


