

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorization for an Account and the Use of Sponsorships, Donations, Sales and
Fundraising derived from the Tohono O'odham Nation's Department of Health
and Human Services, Division of Child Welfare Services)**

RESOLUTION NO. 06-771

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) has conducted the Nation's Division of Child**
2 **Welfare Services and related events, such as the annual Children's Homes'**
3 **Christmas Party, under the supervision of the Nation's Department of Health and**
4 **Human Services, with funds authorized and appropriated by the Nation; and**
5 **WHEREAS, funding appropriated by the Nation provides a base, for which the Division of Child**
6 **Welfare Services operates its programs and related events; and**
7 **WHEREAS, the Division of Child Welfare Services has solicited sponsorships and donations to**
8 **supplement funds budgeted for the Division of Child Welfare Services and related**
9 **events; and**
10 **WHEREAS, such sponsorships and donations provide not only funding support for the Division**
11 **of Child Welfare Services in its efforts to improve services and to plan and conduct**
12 **related events such as the annual Children's Homes' Christmas Party, but also are**
13 **of benefit to the businesses and organizations and private individuals providing**
14 **sponsorships and donations, as it provides advertising and public relations value,**
15 **and it promotes giving and sharing; and**
16 **WHEREAS, the Division of Child Welfare Services and the Nation wish to continue providing**
17 **advertising and public relations opportunities and promoting giving and sharing**
18 **for the Nation, businesses, organizations and private individuals, by continuing to**
19 **solicit and welcome sponsorships and donations; and**
20 **WHEREAS, the Division of Child Welfare Services will utilize funds received by sponsorships**
21 **and donations to subsidize costs and expenses for its programs and related events;**
22 **and**
23 **WHEREAS, other events and activities held before, during, and after the annual Children's**
24 **Homes' Christmas Party also generate income for the Division of Child Welfare**
25 **Services, including but not limited to food sales, other sales and fundraisers; and**
26 **WHEREAS, the Division of Child Welfare Services is seeking authorization from the Legislative**
27 **Council to allow the Division to utilize any and all funds received from sponsors,**

1 **WHEREAS, the Division of Child Welfare Services will report annually to the Legislative Council**
2 **on how funds were received and spent from sponsors, donors and sales.**

3 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
4 **authorize the creation of an account for the Nation's Department of Health and**
5 **Human Services, Division of Child Welfare Services to use, receive and expend any**
6 **and all funds from sponsors, donors, sales and fundraising, to supplement funds**
7 **allocated by the Nation.**

8 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the accounting of all funds received will be maintained by the**
9 **Nation's Accounting Department, and a reporting of how all funds were received**
10 **and spent from sponsors, donors, sales and fundraising, will be presented annually**
11 **to the Legislative Council by the Division of Child Welfare Services.**

12 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17TH. Day**
13 **of NOVEMBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,856.4 FOR; 169.0**
14 **AGAINST; 415.4 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
15 **Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
16 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
17 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
18 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


