

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the FY 2007 DHHS - Division of Community Health/Motor Vehicle**  
**Injury Prevention (STOP Project))**

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-850**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Motor Vehicle Injury Prevention Grant,**  
2 **known as the Securing Tohono O'odham People (STOP) Project; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Division of Community Health desires to continue the prevention services of the**  
4 **STOP Project to reduce motor vehicle injuries and deaths; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Community Health Division has received Year Three continuation funding from**  
6 **the U.S. Center for Disease Control and Prevention; and**

7 **WHEREAS, a budget in the amount of \$69,550 is submitted for review and approval by the**  
8 **Department of Human Services, Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative oversight**  
9 **committees, Health & Human Services and Budget & Finance, to utilize funds to**  
10 **continue the services it provides.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 12 **1. It hereby approves the funding of the Motor Vehicle Injury Prevention Project**  
13 **from the U.S. Center for Disease Control and Prevention and approves**  
14 **expenditures in accordance with the attached budget in the amount of \$69,550.**
- 15 **2. That the duration of this grant shall be from September 01, 2006 through August**  
16 **31, 2007 and remain in effect as long as the U.S. Center for Disease Control and**  
17 **Prevention agrees to fund the Motor Vehicle Injury Prevention Project (STOP**  
18 **Project).**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
20 **Nation officials, to wit: the Chairwoman and any designated official are hereby**  
21 **authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**  
22 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for**  
23 **further prior approval.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
25 **of DECEMBER, 2006 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**  
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**  
27 **VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
30 **Stat. 984).**




